SECTION A - TECHNICAL INFORMATION

1 INTRODUCTION

The Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) is one of the leading scientific research and technology development organisations in Africa. In partnership with national and international research and technology institutions, CSIR undertakes directed and multidisciplinary research and technology innovation that contributes to the improvement of the quality of life of South Africans. The CSIR's main site is in Pretoria. However, it is represented in other provinces of South Africa through regional offices. An expression of interest (EOI) is required to establish a pool of suitable, pre-qualified suppliers for the provision, installation, and maintenance of CCTV systems as part of future proposals on an "as and when required" basis for an estimated period of three (3) years.

2 BACKGROUND

The Defence & Security Cluster of the CSIR conducts multi-disciplinary research and development on various defence and security topics for the benefit of various organs of state and industry. The Cluster has extensive, capital-intensive test and evaluation facilities as well as a deep skills base in various fields of science and technology, including but not limited to Aeronautics Systems, Command & Control, Information & Cyber Security, Landward Sciences, Optronic Sensor Systems as well as Radar & Electronic Warfare. The Cluster undertakes various activities that cover basic research, applied research, test and evaluation, technology development, technology localisation, technology commercialisation and custom solution development for a variety of applications. In line with the CSIR's mandate, the Optronic sensor systems (OSS) Impact Area is developing intelligent visual surveillance systems. The increasing need for intelligent visual surveillance in commercial, law enforcement and military applications makes automated visual surveillance systems one of the main current application domains in computer vision. As a result, OSS has a requirement to source suppliers, installers, support, and maintenance services of smart Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) suites in the above-mentioned fields.

3 INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Expressions of interest are therefore hereby invited from suitably qualified service providers for services required in the provision, installation, and maintenance of CCTV systems.

Note: Suppliers must be willing to operate in other provinces or nationwide.

4 EXPRESSION OF INTEREST REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESS

Evaluation criteria and scoring applicable is provided in Annexure A. Submissions to this EOI will be evaluated against the criteria in Annexure A, so that the CSIR can establish a prequalified pool of service providers.

If all the required criteria are met with respect **Annexure A**, including the supply of all necessary documentary proof, the CSIR reserves the right to undertake an onsite assessment before a service provider is added to the pre-qualified pool of service providers/suppliers associated with this EOI. Any onsite assessment will be coordinated appropriately with the service provider/supplier.

Each expression of interest submitted shall be valid for a minimum period of three (3) months calculated from the closing date.

The CSIR will inform all applicants that successfully meet the pre-qualification criteria in due course. These applicants will be included in the pre-qualified pool (database) of service providers/suppliers associated with this expression of interest.

Once the pre-qualified database of service providers/suppliers is established, suppliers will be approached for quotations on specific requirements on an "as and when required" basis.

The necessary documentation (which may include specifications, design packs, acceptance criteria, timelines and other critical information required) will only be provided by the CSIR per requirement, so that the relevant pre-qualified service providers/suppliers are able to develop quotations/proposals for consideration by the CSIR. Subsequently, the CSIR may consider awarding work (via a contract or purchase order) to pre-qualified service providers/suppliers whose proposal is determined to be the most advantageous to the CSIR, taking into consideration the technical (functional) solution, price, and Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE).

5 TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

5.1 Refer to **Annexure A** for the evaluation criteria that will be used for the technical evaluation for provision of services listed in Section 3.

6 ELIMINATION CRITERIA

An expression of interest will be eliminated under the following conditions:

- 6.1 Proposals not submitted to tender@csir.co.za
- 6.2 Proposals submitted after closing date and time.
- 6.3 Failure to provide documentary evidence on ALL relevant evaluation criteria as per Annexure A.
- 6.4 Failure to submit a company profile.

7 NATIONAL TREASURY CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE REGISTRATION

The following items are required from qualifying suppliers/service providers before they can be registered on the CSIR pre-qualified database associated with this EOI:

- Be registered on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD).
 Registrations can be completed online at: www.csd.gov.za; and
- Provide the CSIR with their CSD registration number.
- Provide the CSIR with a certified copy of their SANAS approved B-BBEE certificate
 or certified affidavit on DTIC template. If no certificate can be provided, no points will
 be scored during any subsequent proposal/quotation evaluation process. (This
 applies to RSA suppliers only).

9 EOI PROGRAMME

The EOI program, as currently envisaged, incorporates the following key dates:

Closing / submission Date: Tuesday, 21 September, Time: 16:30

The CSIR will inform all successful suppliers/service providers qualifying to be registered on the CSIR supplier database in due course.

10 SUBMISSION OF RESPONSES

- 10.1 All expressions of interest are to be submitted to tender@csir.co.za before 16:30 on 21 September 2021.
- 10.2 All submissions are to clearly indicate the EOI number and the name of the service provider.
- 10.3 Responses submitted by companies must be signed by a person or persons duly authorised.

11 DEADLINE

Expression of interest shall be submitted at the address mentioned above no later than the closing date of Tuesday, 21 September 2021 before 16h30.

Where an EOI is not received by the CSIR by the due date and stipulated place, it will be regarded as a late EOI. Late EOI's will not be considered.

12 EVALUATION PROCESS

The EOI evaluation process will include a technical evaluation in accordance with criteria set out in **Annexure A**. No price evaluation will be done at this stage.

13 ENQUIRIES AND CONTACT WITH THE CSIR

Any enquiry regarding this EOI shall be submitted in writing to CSIR at tender@csir.co.za with "EOI No 8048/21/09/2021: Provision, Installation and Maintenance of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV)" as the subject.

Any other contact with CSIR personnel involved in this expression of interest is not permitted during the EOI process other than as required through existing service arrangements or as requested by the CSIR as part of the EOI process.

14 MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION

All documentation submitted in response to this Expression of Interest must be in English.

15 COST OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Companies are expected to fully acquaint themselves with the conditions, requirements, and specifications of this EOI before submitting responses. Each service provider assumes all risks for resource commitment and expenses, direct or indirect, of EOI preparation and participation throughout the EOI process. The CSIR is not responsible directly or indirectly for any costs incurred by Companies.

16 CORRECTNESS OF RESPONSES

16.1 The service provider must confirm satisfaction regarding the correctness and validity of their EOI.

17 VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- 17.1 Companies should check the numbers of the pages to satisfy themselves that none is missing or duplicated. The CSIR will accept no liability concerning anything arising from the fact that pages are missing or duplicated.
- 17.2 **one electronic copy** of each EOI must be submitted.

18 ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANTS

All potential Companies need to note that consultants will only be remunerated at the rates:

- 18.1 Determined in the "Guideline for fees", issued by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA); or
- 18.2 Set out in the "Guide on Hourly Fee Rates for Consultants", by the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA); or
- 18.3 As prescribed by the body regulating the profession of the consultant.

19 TRAVEL EXPENSES

All potential Companies need to note that travel expenses will be managed as follows should they need to travel on behalf of the CSIR in future:

- 19.1 All travel expenses for the CSIR's account, be it directly via the CSIR's travel agent or indirectly via reimbursements, must be in line with the CSIR's travel policy. The following will apply:
- 19.1.1 Only economy class tickets will be used.
- 19.1.2 A maximum of R1400 per night for accommodation, dinner, breakfast, and parking will be allowed.
- 19.1.3 No car rentals of more than a Group B will be accommodated.

20 ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 20.1 Companies shall not assume that information and/or documents supplied to CSIR, at any time prior to this request, are still available to CSIR, and shall consequently not make any reference to such information document in its response to this request.
- 20.2 Copies of any affiliations, memberships and/or accreditations that support your submission must be included in the response.
- 20.3 An omission to disclose material information, a factual inaccuracy, and/or misrepresentation of fact may result in the disqualification of a response, or cancellation of any subsequent contract.
- 20.4 Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions as set out in this document will invalidate the response.

21 CSIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:

- 21.1 Extend the closing date;
- 21.2 Verify any information contained in a response;

- 21.3 Request documentary proof regarding any tendering issue;
- 21.4 Cancel or withdraw this EOI as a whole or in part; and
- 21.5 Not to include any supplier on the list of suppliers on the approved database based on technical criteria not met.

Evaluation Process

For a respondent to be added to the pre-qualified pool for this category they would have to meet all the general criteria between A1.1 to A1.6 **AND** at least one special criteria between A1.7 to A1.9.

The purpose of this EOI is to conduct the necessary due diligence to pre-qualify suppliers so as to enable a faster quotation/proposal and contracting process "as and when" required. Pre-qualified suppliers will not be eligible to bid for work requiring capabilities that have not been confirmed or validated in this process.

Notes on the Armscor Facility Security Clearance Requirement

Some of the work to be undertaken may require an Armscor Facility Security Clearance. Respondents are required to submit a copy of a valid Armscor Facility Security Clearance to be considered for any security classified work. In these instances RFP's/RFQ's will only be sent to the relevant pre-qualified suppliers with a valid Armscor Facility Security Clearance.
