1 INVITATION FOR QUOTATION

Quotations are hereby invited for the provision of spatial data to be used as input to the various geographic models used by the Urban and Regional Planning research team of the CSIR.

2 QUOTATION REQUIREMENTS

The CSIR would like to appoint a specialist in producing land use and socio-economic trend data at a suburb level which is used as input to the various geographic models used by the Urban and Regional Planning research group in the CSIR.

See table below for full quotation requirements for your information;

Data set	Description
Population distribution	Population distribution for the whole country at the resolution equal to the StatsSA enumeration areas (EAs). As recent as 2016 figures. This dataset must also provide a further demographic breakdown based on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gender - Race - Age - Nr of house holds
Place of work versus place of residence	For the population indicated above, indicate the day-time versus night-time distribution.
Life style index	Index based on income and disposal income to support neighbourhood classification or stratification. Service providers must give an indication on what type of index they can produce in this regard. It should not be a mere sell on of the LSM classifications. It must cover at least all the metros in the country (preferably a national dataset) at a resolution similar to the sub-places (SPs) used by StatsSA.
Land Use data	A national land use dataset on at least an EA level. The service provider must indicate how many classes will be available. It will be to the service provider's advantage if they can produce a comparable time series dataset of the LU classes.
New Development Dataset	A national (or at least metro based) spatial dataset that indicates where current developments (residential, commercial and industrial) or changes are taking place.

3 EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 3.1 Selection of suppliers will be based on the **80/20** preference point system.
- 3.2 Indicate valid B-BBEE status on quotation. No B-BBEE status will equal zero points.
- 3.3 Preference will be given to suppliers with B-BBEE level 1 – 4 contributors
- 3.4 Indicate CSD number (National Treasury Central Supplier Database) on quotation. If not registered yet on CSD, use www.csd.gov.za to register.
- 3.5 No order will be issued or no contract will be signed without a valid CSD number.

4 PRICING QUOTATION

- 4.1 Price needs to be provided in South African Rand (excl. VAT), with details on price elements that are subject to escalation and exchange rate fluctuations clearly indicated.
- 4.2 Price should include additional cost elements such as freight, insurance until acceptance, duty where applicable, etc.
- 4.3 Payment will be according to the CSIR Payment Terms and Conditions.

5 OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 5.1 The supplier shall under no circumstances offer, promise or make any gift, payment, loan, reward, inducement, benefit or other advantage, which may be construed as being made to solicit any favour, to any CSIR employee or its representatives. Such an act shall constitute a material breach of the Agreement and the CSIR shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement forthwith, without prejudice to any of its rights.
- 5.2 A validity period of 90 days will apply to all quotations except where indicated differently on the quote.

6 No goods and/or services should be delivered to the CSIR without an official CSIR Purchase order. CSIR purchase order number must be quoted on the invoice. Invoices without CSIR purchase order numbers will be returned to supplier.
