BACKGROUND TO THE CSIR

1 INVITATION FOR QUOTATION

Quotations are hereby invited for the supply and delivery of a 3D printer that is capable of printing chemically resistant high-performance semi-crystalline engineering thermoplastic polyetheretherketone (PEEK) materials to the CSIR Pharmaceutical Technologies research group.

2 QUOTATION REQUIREMENTS

1.	 3D printer requirements: Printing technology using fused filament fabrication with a swappable single extruder. Printer should support printing of both the chemically resistant high-performance semi-crystalline engineering thermoplastic polyetheretherketone (PEEK) and polyetherimide (PEI), option to also print various other functional plastics such as ABS, PC, NYLON or TPU is preferable. Advanced thermal design with a heated chamber ranging up to 90°C, a platform temperature ranging up to 160°C and an extruder temperature ranging up to 450°C. Ultra-high-resolution, high-quality printing up to 50 microns. Operation requirements should include automatic power failure recovery, automatic build plate levelling and automatic filament absent warnings. Safety certifications FCC, SGS and CE. Build volume minimum of 26cm x 26cm x 26cm To be supplied with 1kg of PEEK filament for initial prototyping and materials testing. 	1

- Quotations are only requested from original equipment manufacturers (OEMs)
 or authorized distributors. The supplier must provide proof of status as an
 authorized distributor if not the OEM.
- Delivery is to be made at CSIR Pretoria: Maximum lead time of eight weeks for delivery after placing order.

3 EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 3.1 Selection of suppliers will be based on the 80/20 preference point system.
- 3.2 Provide a valid copy of a B BBEE Certificate or valid affidavit. No B BBEE status will equal to zero points. B BBEE certificate must be issued by SANAS accredited agency or a valid sworn affidavit in line with DTIC regulations. (RSA suppliers only).
 - B BBEE Verification Agency issued Certificate can be verified on SANAS website on Verification Agency (B BBEE) under Accredited Facilities (Quick Access Links): https://www.sanas.co.za/Pages/index.aspx to check validity of the B BBEE Certificate.
- 3.3 Indicate CSD number (National Treasury Central Supplier Database) on quotation. If not registered yet on CSD, use www.csd.gov.za to register.
- 3.4 No order will be issued, or no contract will be signed without a valid CSD number.

4 Elimination criteria

5 PRICING QUOTATION

- 5.1 Price needs to be provided in South African Rand (excl. VAT) or (Incl VAT), with details on price elements that are subject to escalation and exchange rate fluctuations clearly indicated.
- 5.2 Price should include additional cost elements such as freight, insurance until acceptance, duty where applicable, etc.
- 5.3 Payment will be according to the CSIR Payment Terms and Conditions.

6 OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 6.1 The supplier shall under no circumstances offer, promise, or make any gift, payment, loan, reward, inducement, benefit, or other advantage, which may be construed as being made to solicit any favour, to any CSIR employee or its representatives. Such an act shall constitute a material breach of the Agreement and the CSIR shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement forthwith, without prejudice to any of its rights.
- 6.2 A validity period of 90 days will apply to all quotations except where indicated differently on the quote.
- 7 No goods and/or services should be delivered to the CSIR without an official CSIR Purchase order. CSIR purchase order number must be quoted on the invoice. Invoices without CSIR purchase order numbers will be returned to supplier.
