FOURTEEN years ago, Elana van Zyl called time on her stellar career which had taken her to all the corners of the planet to run fast on track and road, winning world titles and breaking world

records.
Unlike other running leg-Unlike other running leg-ends, such as Sonja Laxton and Colleen de Reuck, who scorned the onset of ageing and con-tinued competing at elite level, Van Zyl chose to expend her competitive juices, building run-ning-related entities, such as the Cape Town Marathon and her long-distance running academy, Endurocad. Apart from two marathons,

Apart from two marathons, run in the US for charity over 10 years ago, a low-profile trail stage run with her husband, former South African track ace Jacques van Rensburg, and the Cape Town Marathon Skm Fun Run this year in tandem with Run this year in tandem with her daughter, Van Zyl has stayed away from formal distance-run-

ning events. Until now. On October 12 Van Zyl will swop her former track spikes and road flats for trail shoes to race South Africa's premier trail event – the Otter African Trail Run.

"Tve always wanted to take on challenges with an element of risk, which I could never do as a professional athlete, such as riding the Cape Epic in my first bike race and climbing Kiliman-jaro via the Western Breach. So when I got an invitation to run. when I got an invitation to run the Otter, I knew I had to accept, even though I have always pre-ferred to run on smooth surfaces than on rough terrain. I guess I

'no-ways' and that I had to race the elite event Otter Run. I managed to get (husband) Jacques into the race, so I guess there may be a bit of family rivalry!

"I am aiming to run free.
It's a big challenge, as I have never before run longer than 4 hours! I know I can hike all day, but this is different and I don't know how I'll fare. I'm aiming to run between 7 and 8 hours but part of me still wants to see how fast I can go. And there are already a few people who are aiming to beat me so it's starting to feel more of a race than I had intended!"

Irish eager to bounce back

IRELAND will have to quickly adapt to the most humid conditions of their tournament so far tions of their tournament so far against Russia in Kobe today in a game that cannot come soon enough after their shock defeat to Japan, defence coach Andy Farrell said.

With temperatures topping 30°C this week, the closed roof at the Kobe Misaki Stadium made conditions especially difficult when fellow Pool A contenders Scotland beat Samoa on Monday. Scotland beat Samoa on Monday.
Scotland captain Stuart
McNally remarked how he
started sweating just by walking
onto the pitch before the game
while teammate George Horne
said it was one of the slipperiest
balls he had ever dealt with.
"We know the stats from the
last two games that have been
played here, 30 handling errors
in one and 35 in the other so
it's being able to adapt to that,"
said Farrell.
"It's hot and because of the

"It's hot and because of the "It's hot and because of the humidity in the stadium, the ground sweats as well. The conditions are ones that most people are not quite used to, but I suppose we've played in the rain quite a bit as well. It's something that we have to cope with."

Ireland will qualify for the quarter-finals with bonus-point wins over Russia and Samoa, and could still top the pool depend-

ing on results elsewhere.

Describing the defence in Saturday's 19-12 defeat as a mixed bag, given some last-ditch tack-les saved a potentially crucial losing bonus point, Farrell said the team hoped to use an early setback to kick on.

"A setback, you can use it in the right manner," said Farrell who will take over as Ireland coach after the World Cup.

"They're not ideal but you can use them to your advantage and they can be powerful. After a couple of days and understanding the reasons why (we lost), I think we're in good spirits, back on track and ready to prove a point."

With a bonus point expected to be secured against the lowly Russians, whatever the conditions, Farrell said there was no chance of Ireland being complacent after the shock in Shizuoka. "We look back to our last result and that's enough. It doesn't really matter who we're playing this week, whether it's Russia or New Zealand, the same applies. It's about getting back up on the horse and putting in a good performance," he said. "The feeling in the camp is back to excitement and wanting to put things right on the pitch so that can't come quick enough." | Reuters

"I grew up watching Comrades, but I never thought I could run it because it looked too long. But my coach said I could win it.

"So I will never, ever forget that day," Mothibi said. "Even if I were to win it again, which I plan to, this one will always be the one I cherish."

With Steyn and Mothibi having attained some of road running's wildest dreams, the Comrades Marathon Association (CMA) would like to encourage the 27 500 runners who will line up for next year's 95th edition of the race on 14 June to dream big, And so the slogan for the 2020 race is "Iphupho Lami" which means Dare to Dream.






